The ideal candidate will possess strong teaching skills, well-developed organizational skills, an energetic personality and a passion for the sport of rowing. Experience in coaching or education and a solid knowledge of rowing are essential assets. Preference will be given to those with First Aid/CPR certification, Pleasure Craft certification, Police Check and coaching certifications. Successful candidates will be required to attend a Rowing Canada Learn to Row weekend-long workshop and further CRC specific training.

Job Purpose

The primary role of this position is to educate Learn to Row and Youth Camp participants in the basics of rowing and provide an enjoyable and safe experience that will encourage participants to become further involved with the Calgary Rowing Club. The goal of a Summer Instructor is to create a fun atmosphere for participants through confident instruction, enthusiasm and safety.

Summer Instructors are also responsible for ensuring maintenance and cleanliness standards of the Club are met.
