The candidate will be required to attend a Rowing Canada weekend long Learn to Row course in addition to further CRC specific Learn to Row training.

Job Purpose

The primary role of this position is to educate Youth Camp participants in the basics of rowing and provide an enjoyable and safe experience that will encourage participants to become further involved with the Calgary Rowing Club. The goal of a Youth Camp Instructor is to create a fun atmosphere for participants through confident instruction, enthusiasm and safety.
